CLEAN AND GREEN CAMPUS POLICY DOCUMENT

Green Campus, Energy, and Environment Policies will create exciting new cocurricular and extracurricular initiatives that motivate learners to take the lead in bringing about great change. These activities aim for a comprehensive examination of all infrastructure and administrative operations in terms of energy efficiency, sustainability, and environmental impact. Its green campus programs preserve the environment and ensure a pollution-free, green, and clean campus. It also offers the institution an opportunity to take the lead in redefining its environmental culture through instilling environmental ethics among the students and staff. With the educational policies applied on campus, its simple task is environment development.

Objectives:-

- 1. To sensitize students and staff to minimize the use of polluting products and use environment-friendly products and services.
- 2. To instill the importance of cleanliness for a healthy life
- 3. To Create awareness about environmental issues by organizing Events, Rallies, Awareness Campaigns, Cleanliness Drives, Seminars, Workshops, presentations, Tree Plantation Drives, , etc.

4. To make students and staff aware about raising voice against the hazardous practices destroying Nature and promote environment friendly practices among the society.

Strategies of implementation should be ingrain in students, teachers, and others-

1. Restricted entry of Automobiles:

- All vehicles of college staff/ faculty members are mandated to carry a valid PUC certification before entering the vehicle in college campus.
- To reduce emissions, the college encourages staff and students to park their vehicles in parking area bit away from college campus.
- Restricted entry of automobiles and its use inside the campus keeps it clean and green.

2. Pedestrian-friendly pathways:

- Pedestrian Friendly Pathways for the safe and easy movement of Staff & Students in the campus.
- All buildings on campus are accessible through roadways with pavements and paths.
- The maintenance staff cleans and maintains them on a regular basis.

3. Ban on Single-Use Plastic:

The campus of Sitabai Thite College of Pharmacy, Shirur is a plastic-free campus where there is a complete ban on single-use plastics in classrooms, laboratories, canteen, hostel, and in the other premises.

The college facilitates environment friendly substitutes like stainless steel, washable and a reusable tumbler at all water units and mandates the canteen to serve only in stainless steel or paper plates/glasses/cups to systematically ban the use of plastics on the campus.

4. Landscaping with trees and plants:

As per the Clean and Green Policy of the College, the college strives to plant various types of ornamental and medicinal variety, wild plant species of trees in large numbers within and outside the campus.

Gardeners and full time adequate support staff have been appointed for the maintenance of gardens and keeping the campus litter-free, clean and Green Campus.

The College Medicinal Plant Garden "Agasteya", and the Vermicomposting Unit are looked after and maintained by the Department of Pharmacognosy.

The tree-plantation drives are undertaken by the NSS and SWO Units of the college on regular basis. Cleaning of the Area

5. Energy saving:

- Energy audit to be conducted through a certified agency.
- Our college infrastructure is planned such using more natural sunlight
- Create the habit of switching off lights and fans in classrooms and faculty cabins when not in use.
- Our college promoted the use of digital initiatives and e-learning and reduces use of hard copies.
- Promoted the use of LED light instead of fluorescent light.

6. Noise pollution:

- Certain areas like library, class room are declared as Silence zone and noise pollution is kept to minimum on college campus.
- Various display boards have been placed in the library and other places for awareness to maintain silence in the college.

7. Biodiversity:

- The Green Area in the college includes the plants, greenery and sustainability of the campus to ensure that the buildings conform to green standards.
- Reuse of the water shall be done instead of use of freshwater.
- Display of environment protection banners, posters like save water, save energy at prominent places, waste disposal bins for wet and dry waste disposal bins for wet and dry waste disposal are some of the initiatives taken.

- Composting of biodegradable waste to be scientifically done.
- Rain water Harvesting (RWH) is to be done technically.


8. Solar Water Heater in the Girls' Hostel

Solar Water Heater is installed in the Sitai Girls' Hostel of the college for fulfilling the requirement of Hot water.


9. The Green, Environmental and Energy Audit

The Green, Environmental and Energy Audit of the college are done on regular annual basis. The initiative regarding this is taken by the college.






RESTRICTED ENTRY OF AUTOMOBILES










USE OF BATTERY POWERED VEHICLES

IMPORTANT CIRCULAR

Reference: UGC/AICTE Govt. of India Ministry of Human Resources Development Guidelines for ban of plastic use in higher education institute.

Subject: Ban of single use plastic in SCSSS Institute group campus.

All the stake holders of SCSSS's Sitabai Thite College of Pharmacy, Shirur are hereby informed that group has decided to ban single use plastic material in campus with following initiatives;-

- 1. In whole campus premises including canteen, hostel, workplace etc., there will be ban on single use plastic material.
- 2. There will be replacement of the plastic items with any other ecofriendly alternate.

<u>UGC Guidelines for Ban of Plastic Use in Higher Education</u> <u>Institutions</u>

Whereas plastic waste has emerged as one of the biggest environmental concerns adversely impacting the soil, water, health and well-being of citizens at large;

Whereas excess-consumption of plastic combined with limited waste disposal systems has become a challenge to the urban waste disposal systems, and has choked the rivers and watersystems in rural areas;

Whereas the time has come for a systematic campaign to reduce the usage of plastic, especially the single use plastic;

Whereas the Government has decided to take plastic ban as a national level campaign to address the environmental hazards being and bring attitudinal changes that shun use of plastics; and

Whereas the educational institutions have the unique spread and influence to educate the students and households on the need for avoiding usage of plastics,

University Grants Commission hereby issues the following guidelines for all the higher educational institutions in the Country:

Guidelines

1. Scope of guidelines:

- (a) These guidelines are applicable to all the higher educational institutions (HEIs)in the Country.
- (b) They encourage HEIs (universities and colleges) to adopt policies and practicestowards cleaner and plastic free campuses.
- 2. All the HEIs in the Country shall strive to make their campuses 'plastic-free' by systematically banning use of plastics and replacing the same with suitable environmental friendly substitutes.

3. Every HEI shall:

- a. Ban use of single-use plastics in canteens, shopping complexes in the institution's
 - Premises and hostels, etc.
- b. Carry out awareness drives and sensitization workshops on the harmful impacts of single use plastics.
- c. Mandate all students to avoid bringing non-bio-degradable plastic items to the institution.
- d. Encourage their students to sensitize their respective households about harmful effects of plastics and make their households 'plastic free'
- e. Install necessary alternative facilities like water units to avoid the use of plastic water bottles, and encourage use of alternative solutions like cloth bags, paper bags etc., instead of plastic bottles, bags, covers and other goods on

campuses.

4. All HEIs which have adopted villages under Unnat Bharat Abhiyan shall undertake a campaign in their adopted villages till they are converted into 'plastic-free villages' throughpromoting awareness and encouraging shift to alternative products.
