When this school of higher learning was erected, one of its primary goals was to impart quality education that would empower the upcoming generation to find self-employment. The institution kept steadily growing, and the Sitabai Thite College of Pharmacy came into being in Year 2001, and it offers advanced education in Pharmacy. Presently the college is offering B.Pharm and D.Pharm courses, and on the anvil are the post-graduate M.Pharm and PhD programmes.

### **INFRASTRUCTURE**



omplete with excellent infrastructure, spacious buildings are provided separately for D.Pharm and B.Pharm departments, admeasuring 2000 sq.mt. and 4000 sq.mt., respectively. And housed in these buildings are well-equipped laboratories, computer laboratories, voluminous libraries, a museum, spacious and airy classrooms, separate common rooms for boys and girls, a spacious auditorium, and recreational facilities. Also provided are residential facilities for boys and girls, which can accommodate 36 and 100 respectively.

Our college bagged the first prize at a dance competition in 2007 at Srujan of Baramati.



## **ADMISSION PROCEDURE**

#### Eligibility and Procedure for Admission:-

#### D.Pharm:-

The candidate should have passed the HSC (Std XII) examination of Maharashtra State Board of Secondary Education or its equivalent examination with PCB/PCM Group.

#### B.Pharm:-

The Candidate should have passed the HSC (Std XII) examination of the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary Education or its equivalent examination with PCB/PCM group with English as one of the subjects and should have secured minimum 50 per cent marks (45 per cent for backward class candidates from Mah) and passed MAH PHCET secured Non Zero Marks or D.Pharmacy with Minimum 50% marks.

**FEES:** A student has to pay the college fee which is approved by Shikshan Shulk Samiti from time to time.

The rules and regulations as laid lawn by the Govt. of Maharashtra, AICTE, PCI and DTE from time to time shall be applicable and binding on the candidate.



### **COURSES OFFERED**

#### 1) Bachelor of Pharmacy (B.Pharm)

A four-year full time Degree course in Pharmacy. (B.Pharm) of the University of Pune with 60 students. approved by AICTE, PCI and Govt. of Maharashtra.

#### Curriculum and Examination:-

Curriculum planning and implementation, and the conduct of examination of B.Pharm, are managed by the University of Pune as per norms. Upon successful completion of practical training of the prescribed duration, the degree is awarded by the University of Pune. After the completion of B. Pharm, students can apply for registration to the state pharmacy council as per norms.

#### 2) Diploma course in Pharmacy (D.Pharm)

A two-year full-time diploma course in Pharmacy affiliated to MSBTE, Mumbai with 60 seats, approved by AICTE, PCI, DTE and Govt. of Maharashtra.

**Curriculum & Examination** are designed and implemented by PCI, and examinations conducted by MSBTE. Upon successful completion of the course, MSBTE awards the D.Pharm. diploma. After this, students may apply for registration to the State Pharmacy Council, as per norms.



### **DISCIPLINARY POLICY**

**ATTENDANCE:** Students are required to maintain above 85 per cent attendance per semester, failing in which, one will have one's term cancelled, and besides, will be disallowed to participate in the campus recruitment programme. Feedback based on a monthly monitoring of attendance helps the student to maintain the required attendance.

**DRESS CODE** helps to maintain a sense of discipline and the pride of belonging. The dress code should be strictly followed on specified days. One who fails to comply will be disallowed to attend lectures and will be disciplined.

**HOSTEL RULES:** STCOP management has a set of hostel rules which are to be strictly adhered to by boys and girls. Students opting to stay in hostel will sign an undertaking to obey these rules.

**NO RAGGING** of any kind is allowed, and those found guilty will have their admission cancelled with immediate effect. Students are hereby reminded that ragging is an offence as per Hon. Supreme Court and Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act 1999, and that a student found guilty, and hence dismissed, will not be admitted in any other educational institution for a period of five years from the date of dismissal.

All disputes shall be within the jurisdiction of the Shirur Court only.

#### **DRUGS AND ALCOHOL**

Students are expected to abstain from drugs and alcohol during their stay at the college. Violating this rule will lead to cancellation of their admission.


